It's Time to Celebrate Division 8's 150th Anniversary!!!

"150 Years of Dedication to Religion, Heritage, Charity and Community"

How many organizations do you know that are still in existence today after 150 years? Well, the Rev. James T. O'Reilly OSA Division Eight AOH was founded on November 5, 1871, in Lawrence, Massachusetts, and for the past 150 years has helped preserve Irish culture, history and traditions in a multifaceted way. The talents of its members have been recognized beyond the borders of the Lawrence area. The Men's Division has produced two National Presidents, and the Ladies Division one. In addition to these three National Presidents, three members have served as National Directors of the Order. Several members have gone on to serve in elected and appointed positions at the National, State and County Board levels.

Division 8 locally due, to your support, has been involved in a host of community endeavors and has been supportive of many civic and charitable causes. The Division yearly hosts numerous social events and activities and has scholarship opportunities on the high school and college level, including a college scholarship for study in Ireland.

Division 8, under the guidance of the late David R. Burke, developed; and today volunteer members assist in maintaining a collection of over 20,000 plus Irish books, media and memorabilia that is housed at the South Lawrence Branch Library in Lawrence. This collection is one of the largest Irish Collections on the east coast of the United States, which in itself is a remarkable achievement. Division 8 today has partnered in many cultural endeavors with the New England Irish Cultural Center in Canton, MA, the Burns Library at Boston College, the Maine Irish Heritage Center in Portland Maine amongst others.

In 2006, Division 8 erected a \$40,000 Great Hunger Memorial at the Immaculate Conception Cemetery to honor the memory not only for the victims of this event, but for all the Irish who came before us and settled in the Greater Lawrence area. In May of each year, the Division holds a service at the Memorial for our deceased ancestors and members.

As you are aware, Division 8 AOH meets at the Claddagh Pub and Restaurant on the second Wednesday of each month. Membership is open to those who are 16 years of age or older; Irish by birth, descent, or adoption, and who are practicing Catholics.
